ITEM NO. 1: RESOLVED that the Town Meeting authorize an expenditure not to exceed \$14,000 from earmarked funds in the Capital Non-Recurring Fund for capital projects involving the Sherman School to purchase a fresh air system for the Kindergarten wing. Motion made by Paul Mucci, seconded by Jamie Spannhake and explained by Kevin Keenan. After discussion the motion CARRIED by a show of cards.

ITEM NO. 2: RESOLVED that the Town Meeting authorize an expenditure not to exceed \$14,000 from earmarked funds in the Capital Non-Recurring Fund for capital projects involving the Sherman School to purchase updated software for the Johnson Controls climate control system. Motion made by Paul Mucci, seconded by Jamie Spannhake and explained by Kevin Keenan. After discussion the motion CARRIED by a show of cards.

ITEM NO. 3: RESOLVED that the Town Meeting accept a grant in the amount of \$4,000 from the Iroquois' Community Grant Program and authorize the expenditure thereof for the purchase of fencing and water pump for the children's garden at Munch Meadow. Motion made by John O'Connor, seconded by Paul Mucci and explained by First Selectman O'Connor. After discussion the motion CARRIED by a show of cards.
